BACKGROUND

Retail Competition and Open Access (RCOA) Get-Together

In reference to our letter dated 04 March 2013 for the event involving Contestable Customers (CCs) and Suppliers which we colned as "RCOA Get-Together" on Wednesday, 20 March 2013 at 1:00 pm to be held at SGV Hall, Asian Institute of Management (AIM), 123 Paseo De Roxas, Makati City, may we request your participation by providing a five-minute presentation during the event which entails the CCs' expectations on the implementation of RCOA specifically on the Suppliers' general terms of offers, price range, supply portfolios, value-added services, strategies for contracting, etc. Attached also is the final program for your reference. We will highly appreciate your confirmation and submit your presentation on or before 14 March 2013 through our staff, Ms. Precious M. Cruz.

The TOR

-provides the **minimum requirements** for an RES or Local RES to qualify as an electricity supplier.

- -includes compliance to:
- 1) The **Code of Conduct** and Obligations to be observed;
- 2) The Government Procurement Reform Act

BSP Objective:

To **procure the services** of a Retail Electricity Supplier (RES) or Local RES which will provide *continuous supply of electricity*.



Contract Duration:

Supply and delivery of electricity for a period of **three (3) years**.

Multi-year Contract Agreement



Performance Standards:

- 1. RES shall be responsible for <u>procuring</u> energy **and all other related services** on behalf of the BSP, *i.e., distribution, transmission, administrative charges.*
- 2. RES shall <u>coordinate</u> with the DU, TransCo, and generating companies to restore supply of electricity within reasonable time during force majeure situations.
- 3. RES shall <u>provide</u> Load Profile Studies and Energy Utilization Evaluation.



Obligations of the Electricity Supplier:

- 1. To <u>provide</u> **Disclosure Statement** which includes RES's applicable fees and charges, promos, and other value-added services.
- 2. To <u>remit</u> **all payments due** to the DU, TransCo, WESM or the generating company, and other entity from which it purchased products and services to supply electricity.
- 3. To observe the Terms of Contractual Agreements.
- 4. To observe the cooling-off period.

Code of Conduct for Suppliers:

Disclosure Statement and Retail Supply Contract

- 1. Details of all applicable **prices**, **charges**, **and service levels** that will apply to the BSP
- 2. Any **price and charges payable** under or in connection with the Retail Supply Contract (RSC)
- 3. Any additional charge of any type which may be payable under the RSC, e.g. penalty fees, interest expenses
- 4. **Circumstances** by which BSP may be <u>transferred to</u> the <u>Supplier of Last Resort</u> (SOLR).

Eligibility and Technical Requirements:

- 1. **Valid license from ERC** as generator, wholesale aggregator, IPPs, and/or administrator of IPP contracted capacity
- 2. **Certificate of Registration** from PEMC as direct WESM member
- 3. Detailed **tariff structure** including derivation of the generation rate
- 4. Tariff Rate Adjustment/ Indexation formulae







Should NOT *exceed* **BSP's Generation Rate**

Based on Meralco's **Load Profile** and **Monthly Billings** for the last 12 months
